# Awards to LA Artists and Scholars Program (ATLAS)

### **Program Objective:**

The ATLAS program provides support for the completion of original works of art and scholarship.

#### **Eligibility:**

- Project period 1 year (start date June 1, 2024 and end date June 30, 2025).
- Maximum funding request is \$50,000.
- Eligible disciplines:
  - Creative Arts
  - Humanities
  - o Social Sciences

**NOTE**: The topic of the proposal determines eligibility, not the academic background of the applicant.

## **ATLAS Funding Guidelines**

- PI salary & fringe benefits (50% academic year + 50% summer)
  - 1:1 match required from submitting department and/or college
- Student and support personnel
- ♣ Travel
- Supplies
- **Equipment**
- Publication costs
- Other expenses

# **ORSP Budgetary Guidelines**

Pls must use the EXCEL budget spreadsheets provided on the <u>ORSP BoRSF webpage</u>. These spreadsheets contain additional budget information and will automatically calculate the correct fringe benefits, indirect costs, and the composite budget page.

#### **Relevant Deadlines**

- October 3<sup>rd</sup> NOI uploaded to LOGAN and released to ORSP
- October 10<sup>th</sup> NOI submitted to BoR by ORSP
- ◆ October 16<sup>th</sup> Last day to ask questions about the RFP to BoR, see RFP
- ◆ October 25<sup>th</sup> PI docs to ORSP for 1<sup>st</sup> review by 9 a.m.
- November 1st PI docs to ORSP for 2nd review by 9 a.m.
- ♦ November 15<sup>th</sup> PI docs to ORSP for routing by 9 a.m. Budgets must be FINAL!
- ♦ November 21<sup>st</sup> Proposals submitted by ORSP to BoR via LOGAN
