## Industrial Ties Research Subprogram (ITRS)

#### **Program Objective:**

- ITRS funds research proposals that include private sector involvement and have potential for contributing to the state's economic development.
- All PIs and Co-PIs must be full-time tenured, tenure-track, or research professors.

#### **Eligibility:**

- PI/Co-PI can serve on a maximum of 2 ITRS proposals, 2 PoC/P proposals, or a combination of 2 projects at any one time.
- Project period 1 to 3 years (start date June 1, 2024).
- \* \$350,000 total project request. First year request may not exceed \$150,000. Total requests for years 2 & 3 may not exceed \$100,000/year.
- All disciplines/focus areas are eligible; however, preference will be given to those submitted under the following target areas:
  - \* Advanced Materials & Manufacturing
  - \* Life Sciences & Bioengineering
  - \* Digital Media & Enterprise Software
- \* Coastal & Water Management
- \* Clean Technology & Energy

### **ITRS Funding Guidelines**

- ♦ PI salary & fringe benefits (up to 25% academic year plus 2 summer months)
- Student and support personnel
- Travel
- Supplies
- Equipment (must include a 25% cash match)
- Publication costs
- Other expenses

#### **ORSP Budgetary Guidelines**

Pls must use the EXCEL budget spreadsheets provided on the <u>ORSP BoRSF webpage</u>. These spreadsheets contain additional budget information and will automatically calculate the correct fringe benefits, indirect costs, and the composite budget page.

- ◆ October 11<sup>th</sup> PI docs to ORSP for 2<sup>nd</sup> review by 9 a.m.
- October 16<sup>th</sup> Last day to ask questions about the RFP to BoR, see RFP
- October 25<sup>th</sup> PI docs to ORSP for routing by 9 a.m. Budgets must be FINAL!
- October 31st Proposals submitted by ORSP to BoR via LOGAN
