Research Competitiveness Subprogram (RCS)

Key updates to the RCS for 2025-2026 Cycle highlighted below.

Program Objective:

The RCS program supports Louisiana university researchers, fostering fundamental research to strengthen competitiveness, overcome barriers, and achieve sustained success in external funding.

Eligibility:

- Expanded eligibility: Open to faculty at any rank (<u>either senior or junior status</u>) who face identifiable barriers to securing federal or other external research funding
- All Pls and Co-Pls must be <u>full-time tenured</u> or <u>tenure-track faculty</u>.
- Faculty may serve as PI/co-PI on a maximum of 1 RCS project at any one time.
- One-year award period: Project period of 1 year (start date June 1, 2026 and end date June 30, 2027).
- Maximum funding request of \$200,000. Increased budget limits: Reflects shorter award period and inclusion of higher-cost equipment.
- Eligible disciplines:
 - * Biological Sciences

- * Chemistry
- * Computer & Information Sciences
- * Health and Medical Sciences
- * Earth and Environmental Sciences * Engineering B (Industrial, Materials, Mechanical, etc.)

NOTE: The topic of the proposal determines eligibility, not the academic background of the applicant.

RCS Funding Guidelines

- ◆ PI salary & fringe benefits (25% academic year + 2 summer months)
- Student and support personnel
- Travel
- 🍁 Supplies
- Equipment (Fully allowable as a budget item; institutional match requirement removed)
- Publication Costs
- Other expenses

ORSP Budgetary Guidelines

Pls must use the EXCEL budget spreadsheets provided on the <u>ORSP BoRSF webpage</u>. These spreadsheets contain additional budget information and will automatically calculate the correct fringe benefits and indirect costs

Relevant Deadlines

- ❖ September 2nd NOI uploaded by PI to LOGAN & released to ORSP
- September 11th NOI submitted to BoR by ORSP
- September 24th PI docs to ORSP for 1st review by 9 a.m.
- October 1st Last day to ask questions about the RFP to BoR, see RFP
- ♦ October 1st PI docs to ORSP for 2nd review by 9 a.m.
- October 8th PI docs to ORSP for routing by 9 a.m. All documents must be FINAL!
- October 13th Proposals submitted to BoR by ORSP
