Research Competitiveness Subprogram (RCS) One-Year Research Component

Program Objective:

- The objective of the RCS One-Year Research Component is to stimulate and support faculty, on a limited basis in their exploration of novel science and engineering research leading to near-term federal support.
- All PIs and Co-PIs must be full-time tenured or tenure-track faculty.

Eligibility:

- Faculty may serve as PI/co-PI on a maximum of 1 RCS or RCS One-Year project at any one time (This includes RCS or RCS One-Year Funding in last year's competition).
- Project period of 1 year (start date June 1, 2024 and end date June 30, 2025).
- Maximum funding request of \$20,000.
- Eligible disciplines:
 - * Biological Sciences
 - * Computer & Information Sciences
 - * Earth and Environmental Sciences
- * Agricultural Sciences
- * Engineering A (Chemical, Civil, Electrical, etc.)
- * Mathematics
- * Physics/Astronomy
- * Social Sciences

NOTE: The topic of the proposal determines eligibility, not the academic background of the applicant.

RCS Funding Guidelines

- Travel
- Supplies
- Equipment (must include a 25% cash match)
- Publication Costs
- Other expenses
- RCS One-Year will not support salary or fringe for faculty or support personnel

ORSP Budgetary Guidelines

Pls must use the EXCEL budget spreadsheets provided on the <u>ORSP BoRSF webpage</u>. These spreadsheets contain additional budget information and will automatically calculate the correct fringe benefits, indirect costs, and the composite budget page.

Relevant Deadlines

- September 11th NOI submitted to BoR by ORSP
- ◆ October 11th PI docs to ORSP for 1st review by 9 a.m.
- ◆ October 16th Last day to ask questions about the RFP to BoR, see RFP
- ♦ October 18th PI docs to ORSP for 2nd review by 9 a.m.
- November 1st PI docs to ORSP for routing by 9 a.m. Budgets must be FINAL!
- ♦ November 7th Proposals submitted by ORSP to BoR via LOGAN
